

## Netball Holiday Camp Information Sheet for Parents/ Guardians

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Organising your Child/Children for the school holidays can be a very stressful time so we hope this information will be of some assistance.

We would like to take this opportunity to tell you a little about our Everyone Active & Hertfordshire Mavericks Netball Camps. This is a netball specific holiday camp for children aged 7-9 and 9-13years old where the children are fully supervised by our Mavericks approved Netball Coaches between 10am – 3pm. It is essential that the correct date of birth is given at the time of booking. When filling in the booking form please make sure you include your child's t-shirt size for their FREE Mavericks T-shirt which they will be able to collect on the first morning of the camp.

Our netball camps have been developed to provide children aged from 7 to 13 years old with the best possible introduction to the sport of netball. The program incorporates skill activities, fun games and modified matches. Delivered in a fun and safe environment by accredited coaches, ensure all participants have an enjoyable experience, while developing fundamental life skills. These camps provide a great opportunity for children whether as an introduction to the joys of team sport or the start of a lifelong passion for netball.

Please make sure that your child/ children are wearing appropriate clothing including trainers or suitable shoes for sports activities. Please ensure that you children also have suncream and hat for when the weather is warm.

Our aim is to make your child's/ children's day as safe as possible. The centre operates a **NO BULLYING POLICY** your child/ children must have an understanding that challenging behaviour will not be tolerated, our Netball Coaches will be acting in "loco parentis". If an incident arises they will speak to the child/ children who are having difficulty and try to resolve any problems before we contact the parent/guardian.

Parent/guardian will provide children with a packed lunch which is labelled with their name. The food within the lunch box provided by the parent/guardian must be suitable for the child's dietary requirements. They will also be expected to bring a named water bottle with suitable drinking water which can also be replenished throughout the day.
